





The M/V Sea Spirit is an adventure ship and mega-yacht for 114 travelers. All-suite vessel provides the level of comfort that nobody expects to experience in wild places like Antarctica or the Arctic: some of the suites even feature private balconies accessed via sliding glass doors! An ice-strengthened hull, a fleet of Zodiacs for forays ashore, experienced crew, and retractable fin stabilizers for smoother sailing make expeditions aboard this ship adventurous yet comfortable and safe. Inside the ship is a 'floating hotel' with spectacular views from every window, superb international cuisine, and luxury amenities. This ship is among eight Renaissance small cruise ships built in 1991. The concept was, maybe, too innovative for those times, and Renaissance sold the fleet. Nowadays both ships are bringing comfort and style into expedition cruising.

The Arctic is home to polar bears, walruses and many species of birds, as well as mysterious geological formations found nowhere else on earth. The trip is made by sea, aboard Russian nuclear icebreaker and Zodiac boats; in the air, aboard a helicopter departing from the ship or a hot-air balloon; and on land, in perhaps the most thrilling portion of the journey. Travelers will stand at exactly 90 degrees north at the top of the world, where they will "walk around the world," enjoy a barbecue on the ice and, for the more daring and adventurous, plunge into the Arctic Ocean for an icy swim. Aboard the ship and on the ice, professionals, experts and scientists who have studied the Arctic for decades provide lectures and information at every step of the way. Their knowledge and expertise make the journey educational as well as exciting.



50 Years of Victory is the largest and most modern nuclear-powered icebreaker in the world. For those with an appreciation of such vessels, it is an upgrade of the Arktika-class, the most powerful icebreakers in the world. It travels from Murmansk, Russia, to the North Pole.

Among its state-of-the-art features are:

- the most up-to-date nuclear safeguards and protection systems As a working icebreaker, it is highly suitable to life onboard. It holds 128 passengers and 140 crew members. Its cabins and suites are comfortable and spacious, with room for socializing and get-togethers. Among the public spaces are: dining room-unreserved seating; Aft Saloon for lectures, presentations and socializing; bar & lounge with front view; library & lounge; gym; two saunas and swimming pool with heated sea water. There is also a clinic with a licensed doctor.







Reservations and payment.

A deposit of 20% of the appropriate cabin rate is required to confirm reservation with final payment due 90 days prior to departure. All prices and payments are in U.S. dollars and no other currencies will be accepted. Cancellation and Refunds. All requests for cancellation must be made in writing. Cancellations received 120 days prior to departure will be fully refunded less an administrative fee of 5% of the applicable cabin rate per person. Cancellations received between 121 days and 91 days prior to departure will be fully refunded less the deposit of 20% of the applicable cabin rate per person. Please note that within the 90-day period all deposits and other payments are forfeited. If cancellation is received 90 days or fewer prior to the beginning of the voyage, all payments are forfeited (applicable cabin rate per person plus cost of charter flight - North Pole). For these and other reasons mentioned below, passengers are strongly encouraged to obtain trip cancellation insurance. Prices quoted are based on group participation, and no refunds will be made for any part of the program in which passengers choose not to participate, including any helicopter flight time, Zodiac boat trips or other excursions (if applicable and which at the discretion of the captain and expedition leader may or may not be utilized). Refunds will not be made to passengers who do not complete the tour for any reason whatsoever. World Quest Cruises (WQC

hereafter) reserves the right to cancel any departure due to insufficient reservations up to eight weeks before the date of departure (passengers may be offered alternative cruise dates). WQC also reserves the right to cancel any departure up until the date of that departure due to force majeure or other circumstances beyond the control of WQC that prevent the operation of the tour (this also includes governmental and administrative decisions). WQC or its agents are not responsible for any costs or penalties relating to air transport or other services that are cancelled. WQC is not liable for failure to provide the services or accommodations offered to the extent that such services or accommodations cannot be provided due to force majeure or other circumstances beyond its control.

Itinerary. The itinerary described is subject to change at the discretion of the WQC expedition leader, depending on weather conditions, availability of anchorages, political conditions and other factors beyond WQC's control. Participants have no right to any refund or other considerations in the event of such itinerary changes.

All North Pole passengers are covered by medical travel insurance policy to the value of 100,000 euros per person and said policy includes emergency evacuation and repatriation, and is in effect only on board the ship and outside the port of Murmansk. All other insurance is solely at passenger's expence. Travelers to the Arctic and Antarctica are not covered by any insurance purchase appropriate policies on their own. Rates. The published rate is based on the prices, exchange rates, duties and taxes as known to WQC at the time of publication of materials and at the time of travel confirmation. WQC reserves the right to raise the published rate (for such reasons as but not limited to unforeseeable increases in exchange rates, duties, taxes, port fees and fuel prices) if considered necessary by WQC. WQC will inform passengers, tour operators or agents at least 30 days prior to departure. In the event of a price increase of more than 15% of the total price of the trip, passengers, tour operators or agents are entitled to cancel the trip without incurring any costs.
